- tolerance and respect for others as they are, since we live and minister to people of all religions and all cultures
- spiritual formation for children and adults through catechesis
- spiritual accompaniment of youth
- basic Christian communities
- participation in parish life

This year we have been very active in the parish of Blessed Anne-Marie Javouhey in Conakry, which was consecrated on February 1, 2015. The planning and celebration of this event over several weeks, was an opportunity for us to raise awareness about our Mother Foundress' life.
